Pam Moore began her career with Golden Rule Insurance Company in May 1987 in the Sales Services Division. She transferred to Facilities Management as the secretary in December 1989 and from there was promoted to Supervisor in 1995. In 2006, she was promoted to Manager. In her current position as Manager in Administrative Services, she is responsible for Mail Services and Print Operations in addition to Facilities Management.

In her role she maintains 10 buildings totaling 139, 224 sq. ft. located in Illinois and Indiana, and manages a staff of 13.

Her primary responsibilities among others are building renovations and construction, workspace planning and furniture moves. She is responsible for planning and managing several budgets and negotiates service contracts. Pam also functions as the Emergency Response Team Site Lead and maintains and monitors all security and fire systems.

Pam is also responsible for ensuring the smooth operations of Mail Services and Print Operations. Mail Services handles all incoming and outgoing mail and overnight packages. On an average they handle approximately 75,000 pieces of mail monthly serving several different operating departments.

Print Operations prints policy packets that are mailed to new members across the nation and numerous reports used in daily operation within the company. On average, they print over two million images monthly.

Pam is a member of the Rotary Club of Lawrenceville and has been a Chamber member for several years and has served on the Board of Directors.

Golden Rule Insurance Company was founded in 1940 by the late M.A. and Mary Rooney. After 66 successful years Golden Rule was purchased in 2006 by UnitedHealthCare. In October 2007, tragedy struck when fire consumed one of the buildings in the main complex downtown Lawrenceville. Pam and her team, after two years of hard work and determination in planning and construction, completed a new state of the art facility. This beautiful structure was dedicated in honor of Frank S. Ladner for all his contributions to the company and the community.
